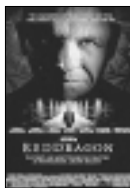
WINDTALKERS

The Players: Nicolas Cage, Adam Beach, Peter Stormare, Noah Emmerich, Mark Ruffalo, Brian Van Holt
The Play: It's WWII. Joe Enders, a decorated Marine who is by-the-book to a fault, is just coming back on duty (by cheating on his medical tests). "Ox" Anderson, much greener, is also getting the same new task: Protect the Navajo codetalkers (Ben Yehzee and Charles Whitehorse, respectively). While Enders is initially frustrated with his assignment, his respect grows as the codetalkers prove their worth in the brutal battle to take Saipan.



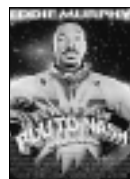
RED DRAGON

Players: Anthony Hopkins, Edward Norton, Ralph Fiennes, Harvey Keitel, Emily Watson, Mary-Louise Parker
The Play: A set of grisly murders brings FBI Agent Will Graham (Norton) out of retirement and puts him in search of an atrocious killer (Fiennes) who's driven by the image of a painting. Yet his only means of survival and success are to seek the help of another madman, whom he himself captured, Dr. Hannibal Lecter (Hopkins). Marked by past scars and quickly running out of time, Graham finds himself tangled in a heap of madness, sacrificing his work, his family, and above all his own life, to put an end to pure evil.



THE ADVENTURES OF PLUTO NASH

Players: Eddie Murphy, Randy Quaid, Rosario Dawson, Pam Grier, Joe Pantoliano
The Play: Set on the moon in the year 2087, Pluto Nash (Eddie Murphy) is an audacious nightclub owner who finds himself in hot water when he refuses to sell his club to the local mob. As the film starts, Pluto has been out of prison a week and is already saving the lives of Polish accordion players in kilts, negotiating bookies into lending him millions of dollars and turning the worst bar on the moon into the satellite's hottest nightclub. Cut to seven years later, and Pluto's club is hot. A charming wannabe singer comes into the club looking for work about five minutes before it gets blown up, leaving only Pluto, the singer and an antiquated security robot named Bruno (Randy Quaid).



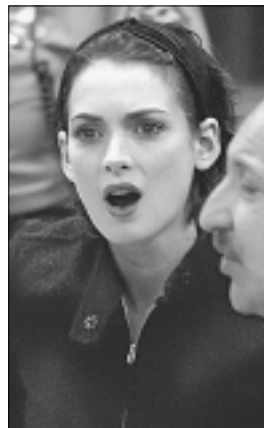
TRAPPED

The Play: Joe Hickley thinks he's got a great scheme: kidnap the child of rich parents, hold it for 24 hours, keeping the mother under his control while an accomplice gets the ransom from the father, who is on a trip. But things go very wrong when he tries this scheme on the Jennings family, in part because their daughter Abby is asthmatic, and in part because the Jennings' find out more than Hickley wants them to know.



Ryder is put on probation and fined for shoplifting

BEVERLY HILLS, California — Winona Ryder was sentenced Friday to work with the sick, the blind and babies with AIDS as part of a probationary term for stealing more than \$5,500 worth of high-fashion merchandise from a Saks Fifth Avenue store.

"If you steal again, you will go to jail," Superior Court Judge Elden Fox told the actress, who sat watching him solemnly and acknowledged the warning.

The judge ordered her to undergo psychological and drug counseling because "there's going to be a need for you to confront what I consider aberrant behavior."

A probation report, which the defense unsuccessfully sought to keep sealed, cited an investigation that found Ryder had received 37 medications from 20 doctors between January 1996 and December 1998.

He imposed three years of probation and said Ryder must appear in court April 7 for a status report.

Ryder also was ordered to perform 480 hours of community service — 240 hours at the City of Hope medical center, 120 hours at the Foundation for the Junior Blind, and 120 hours at the Caring for Babies With Aids foundation.

She was ordered to pay \$3,700 in fines and restitution of \$6,355 to Saks.

Ryder faced up to three years in prison, but prosecutors did not recommend any time behind bars because she had no prior convictions.

Her lawyer, Mark Geragos, suggested that Ryder has been punished more than the average person would be because of the

public attack on her character.

"I don't think that one crime should trump all the good she's done in her life," Geragos said, citing Ryder's work with American Indian causes and with the Polly Klaas Foundation for missing children.

At one point, prosecutor Ann Rundle began an angry speech concerning numerous references to the Klaas Foundation. Mark Klaas has supported Ryder, who donated a reward after his 12-year-old daughter was kidnapped from home and slain in 1993.

"What's offensive to me is to trot out the body of a dead child," the prosecutor began. "I've heard this for over a year."

Geragos objected loudly and Ryder rose partly from her seat, glaring. The judge admonished Rundle to stick to the shoplifting case.

Outside court, Klaas said he was outraged by the reference to his daughter and credited Ryder with an unsolicited act of benevolence.

"Winona Ryder may be a double-felon, but she's a double-felon with a heart," he said.

The two-time Academy Award nominee was convicted last month of felony grand theft and vandalism for her Dec. 12, 2001, shopping trip to the Beverly Hills store.

Ryder had numerous prescription drugs in her possession when she was arrested. One drug court was filed but it was eventually dropped when a doctor said he had prescribed the medication. The probation report revealed she also had a syringe in her purse.

"She had more medication in her purse than would be given to a person with a terminal disease," Rundle said.

Geragos responded that Ryder had "a pain-management problem" for some time. He angrily accused the district attorney's office of "doing everything they could to destroy this woman" and said he had tried repeatedly to settle the case without a trial.

During the trial, jurors were shown videotapes of Ryder wandering through the store's designer boutiques and taking a large number of items into dressing rooms.

Security staff testified that after Ryder was caught, she claimed a film director had told her to shoplift to prepare for a movie role.

Ryder, who began her film career as a teenager in 1986, earned Academy Award nominations for "Little Women" and "The Age of Innocence." She also starred in the movie "Girl, Interrupted." ■
